Engaging Shows

In the interests of continuous improvement, below are some questions to regularly ask yourself about your show.

Are you:-

- Speaking conversationally, direct to each listener?
- Sounding as though you are reading?
- Making smooth transitions – are there “brick walls” between the elements, or does your presentation feel natural and seamless?
- Speaking visually?
- Telling powerful stories?
- Introducing the audience to characters they can care about?
- Funny? Is there an element of humour?
- Taking your audience on a journey?
- Presenting moments that connect?
- Introducing new information?
- Including authentic self-revelation? Do I know YOU from hearing this show?
- Going “personal” without going private?
- Boring? Did anything go too long?
- Taking risks? Any surprises in the show?
- Providing “talkable topics” for your listeners to share with others?
- Having fun?
- Giving your audience enough to make them want to come back?
- Serving your listeners? (Entertained, informed, inspired, persuaded, connected?)
- Compelling? Would your listener sit in a parked car and keep listening?

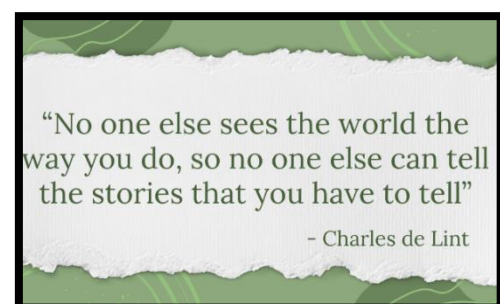
