**We reached out recently to share plans with you about the new homes Kāinga Ora - Homes and Communities are proposing across New Plymouth, including in your area on Glenpark Avenue and Tothill Street.**

Thank you to those who attended our community drop-in sessions and barbecue to share your thoughts and ideas around how we can better support your community. We have really appreciated hearing from you and are making a few changes to ensure the new homes work well for the people and whānau who will live here, as well as the wider community. By building better communities, we provide more stability for new whānau coming into your neighbourhood.

## What's happening?

We have taken the time to look at our proposed housing redevelopments in Glenpark Avenue and we have decided to focus on delivering six new homes across the two sites at 50 & 56 Glenpark Avenue first.

While we are progressing with these homes, we are going to take some time to take another look at the remaining sites to ensure we can deliver something that works well

for the community and the people and whānau in need who will call this neighbourhood home.

In addition, we are exploring whether we could utilise the vacant grassed site at 39 Glenpark Avenue in a way to allow people to connect, learn and be active within the neighbourhood.
